After retiring from the Northern Trust Company—a 38-year career that included 18 as head of the company’s trust division—Bob Reusché still had “a lot of energy and a strong desire to make a valuable contribution in the community.”

Mr. Reusché and his wife Mary began contributing their support and expertise to Public Action to Deliver Shelter and Supportive Services (PADS). Through 15 years of tireless service, the Reuschés have become mentors and champions of the Waukegan program.

A longtime volunteer at The Chicago Community Trust, Mr. Reusché was instrumental in seeding and launching The Lake County Community Foundation. “PADS demonstrates why The Lake County Community Foundation is so important,” Mr. Reusché explains. “Unlike Chicago, Lake County has not historically received significant private support for human services. Subsequently, donor gifts made to The Lake County Community Foundation that support human service organizations have tremendous significance. Within a five minute drive we can show anyone on the North Shore the impact their philanthropy is having right here in their own backyard.”
